

**Agreement between the employer registering workers to the
First Aider Training in the Workplace
and
the Lifesaving Society, authorized CNESST supplier**

1. The company must, at the latest five (5) calendar days before the beginning of the training, inform the Lifesaving Society of any registered worker who will not attend the training by written notice. In witness thereof, the company guarantees the attendance of a number of workers that is equal to the number of workers indicated in the form.

In case of noncompliance with this five (5) calendar day delay, a \$34.00 fee will be invoiced to the company requesting to postpone any registration to another training date.

If the company fails to comply with this five (5) calendar day delay and cancels all registrations, the total cost of the training, including taxes and manuals, will be invoiced by the Lifesaving Society to the company.

2. If a worker fails or does not attend the training, the CNESST grant will still be considered as used. If no grant was available, the total cost of the training, including taxes and manuals, will be invoiced to the company according to the number of workers involved.
3. The company agrees to provide the Lifesaving Society with accurate information to determine ratios and eligibility for grants from the CNESST. In case of non-compliance, the total cost of the training, including taxes and manuals, will be invoiced to the company according to the number of workers involved.
4. If the company chooses to register workers for whom training is not subsidized by the CNESST, the total cost of the training for these workers, including taxes and manuals, will be invoiced to the company according to the number of workers involved.
5. The Lifesaving Society agrees to provide, as scheduled, the First Aider Training in the Workplace for a period of sixteen (16) hours, including breaks and meal breaks, and to issue the awards within the timeframe required by the CNESST.
6. In case of a change in the training schedule, the Lifesaving Society must give a written notice to the company no later than five (5) business days prior to the course, and propose a new schedule as soon as possible.


