

CERTIFICATION STATEMENT

CONTEXT

It is mandatory that candidates who wish to recertify their award through a recertification prove they have the required prerequisites by presenting the award they want to recertify.

The award is therefore used as a proof; the instructor or trainer leading the recertification will refuse access to the recertification to whomever cannot prove they have the required prerequisites.

If you do hold the required award but are unable to present it to the instructor or trainer, you can sign the statement below to attest to the fact that you have the certification needed for this recertification.

The Lifesaving Instructor, Emergency First Aid/AED Instructor and Aquatic Emergency Care/AED awards must have been issued less than 4 years before the recertification. Otherwise, you must contact the office of the lifesaving society.
