Learning outcome

The candidate demonstrates effective individual first aid skills in the management of an injured victim.

Must see

Quick recognition and immediate response

Appropriate selection and effective demonstration of rescue techniques and use of equipment

Effective communication with other lifeguards, victim, patrons, bystanders

Safe and appropriate entry with or without aid (in-water only)

Quick approach and victim support such that victim is unlikely to grasp rescuer (in-water victim only)

Victim removal with assistance if required (in-water victim only)

Effective use of barrier devices (such as pocket mask, gloves) where appropriate

ABC assessment and appropriate first aid treatment (see Appendix A for Must Sees)

Contact with EMS if required

Victim information collected for incident report

Victim reassurance

Concern for personal safety throughout
