

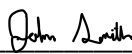
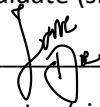

Must-sees: - Safe and appropriate entry with or without an aid: the candidate jumped too closely to the victim; he did not leave a safe distance between him and the victim - Motion of victim's spine restricted during roll-over (if required) and throughout: the candidate had placed his hands at neck level in front and behind, but did not wait for his colleague before dropping the trapezoids.

Strategies to correct the situation	
Practice roll-over for spinal injuries with lifeguards friends. Make sure to always be two armwidths away from the victim when entering the water. Participate in a Reexamination to demonstrate the successful completion of all the training's items.
