

EVALUATION GRID FOR MANAGEMENT

Injured victim: medical, traumatic and/or environmental problems

Pre-hospital clinical assessment (GCSU Item 7)

Approach to the situation

Assess the situation and surroundings. Gloves and pocket mask. Assess the environment.

Introduction and obtaining consent. Witnesses. *Causal mechanism.*

Primary exam (GCSU Item 8)

Assess level of consciousness

Call EMS (if necessary)

Open airway

Assess breathing (visually) for 5-10 seconds maximum

Assess circulation (pulse and severe hemorrhage) if victim is breathing

Secondary exam (GCSU Item 9)

Assess vital signs (consciousness, breathing, circulation, skin and pupils)

Head to toe physical exam

Medical history (SAMPLE, Medic-Alert)

Treatments

WARTS (warmth, ABCs, Rest & reassure, Treatment, Semi-prone/semi-sit)

Enter treatments specific to the problems:

Candidate is able to recognize signs/symptoms and treat them.

Candidate adequately simulates a 9-1-1 call.

Candidate ensures their own safety for the duration of the intervention.

Candidate respects the objectives of emergency care (preserve, prevent and promote).
