Facility info:

- The facility is an 8 lane 25m pool with a constant depth of 3-4m. The temperature of the pool is 82-83 degrees. This will be a short course competition.
- All spectators can view from the upper viewing gallery. There will be no spectators allowed on the pool deck.
- Onsite parking is free, located at the facility.

Eligibility:

Junior Competitors

- Must hold a Lifesaving Society award, be a member of a Lifesaving Club or be registered in a Lifesaving Society training program.
- Meet the Lifesaving Society's Canadian Swim-to-Survive® standard (roll entry, tread water for 1 min. and swim 50m).
- Be at least 7 years of age but less than 17 years of age by April 6, 2024.

Rules and Disqualifications:

- The most up to date Ontario competition manual as of April 6, 2024 will be used.
- Athletes in the 7-11 division will have a 5 second penalty added to their times for any infraction. Athletes in the 12-16 division will be disqualified for every infraction. Use of DQ codes from the ILSF Manual will occur.

Relay

- Relays will be set up as an exhibition event. No awards will be presented.
- Relays will be exhibition and will be any combination of individual and clubs to give as many people as possible an opportunity to participate in the event.
